Terms, Conditions and Extra Information

Adults

We require 2 adults to remain for the duration of a party, for supervision and to accompany children to the toilet (through the car park) if necessary. No adults are required to stay for Saturday Bushcraft Club or Survival School.

Group Numbers for Parties

Twelve children is the maximum for parties—including the birthday girl/boy and any participating siblings. This ensures that all children get to participate fully and are safe.

Age Restrictions

The minimum age is seven or school year group two (this allows children celebrating their 7th birthday to invite friends who may still be six but who are in the same school year).

Consent Forms

These must be completed and returned to Wildly Curious *at least 2 days prior to the party/event*. Please remember to complete a form for the birthday boy/girl and any siblings. We need to buy food before the party/event and to take into account any medical needs. Children will not be able to participate without a completed parent consent form. Party hosts—please either include a form with your invitations, or make sure your guests know where to find it the Wildly Curious website. Please return forms to info@wildlycurious.co.uk

Health and Safety

Each Wildly Curious activity is carefully planned, tried, tested and risk assessed. While this can never totally guarantee that first aid incidents won't happen, activities are carried out in a controlled environment and are closely supervised. Safety is paramount. We provide safety briefings as part of each session, so that both participants and adults are aware of the guidelines for activities, and as such, it is their responsibility to abide by the rules and listen to the instructor/s.

Arrival

Please arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of your party/event. The Wildly Curious meeting point is by The Stove coffee shop—look for the sign. This will give participants time to visit the toilet prior to heading over to the Wildly Curious area. We cannot guarantee that we will be able to extend the length of a party to allow for late arrivals. Please note that pets are not allowed at parties!

Bookings and Payment

Wildly Curious will hold provisional party dates for up to 48 hours. Bookings are confirmed once a £30 deposit has been paid—we will then send you a Party Confirmation form. Payment by bank transfer (BACS) is preferred. Cash and cheques are also accepted, but cheques must be sent early so that they have cleared at least five days prior to the party. The party balance is required at least two weeks before the party date. Wildly Curious will send you a reminder email. Please note that late payment may result in the cancellation of the booking, and the loss of the deposit.

Terms, Conditions and Extra Information

Cancellations

If you cancel your Wildly Curious party, the following fees apply, based on the full party fee. In all circumstances, the £30 deposit is non-refundable.

If you cancel more than 3 months (13 weeks) prior to party: 0 (except £30 deposit)

6—12 weeks to party: 50%

Less than 6 weeks to party: 75%

Less than a week to party: 100%

Please note that we reserve the right to cancel bookings and issue you with a full refund (in case of instructor illness etc), unless the booking has been cancelled due to late payment.

Charges For Unreturned Items

There is a £15 charge per item for unreturned items to cover the cost of replacement. This is for costumes or resources used during the party— we will inform you if an item has not been returned to see if it can be located. No charges will be made for accidental damage.

Inclement Weather

Wildly Curious will still hold parties in the rain. However in the event of heavy snow, gale force winds or thunderstorms, our risk assessment may mean having to delay or postpone the party.
